

PAOLO BULGARI
Chairman of the Bvlgari Group

He was born in Rome on October 8th, 1937.

Since 1984, he has been Chairman of Bulgari S.p.A. where he developed a strategy that has resulted in the rapid growth of the Company.

Since 1984 he has been Chairman of Bulgari Italia S.p.A.

Paolo Bulgari is the grandson of Sotirio, a talented silversmith who founded the family's company after emigrating from his native country Greece. Paolo Bulgari's father, Giorgio, was responsible for introducing the family into the high jewellery business. He also opened the famous Via Condotti store in Rome in 1932.

Paolo Bulgari began assisting his father in 1960, specializing in the study of precious stones, of which he is a well-known expert, and developing the aesthetic sensitivity which is at the base of the Bvlgari style. He continues to work alongside the creative team which is composed of young designers, and he is considered the company's true creative soul.

He collects contemporary art and he is a supporter of nature. He is member of both the "WWF International 1001", for which he promoted the project "A Tribute to Nature" in 1991, as well as "FAI 200" (Italian Foundation for the Environment) which he has supported on various occasions.

NICOLA BULGARI

He was born in Rome in 1941.

Since 1984 he has been Vice Chairman of Bulgari S.p.A. and of Bulgari Italia S.p.A.

Nicola Bulgari is the grandson of Sotirio, a talented silversmith who founded the family's Company after emigrating from his native country, Greece. Together with his brother Paolo, Chairman of the Bvlgari Group, Nicola was introduced to the family business by his father Giorgio in the 1960's.

A keen coin collector, Nicola gave a substantial contribution to one of the Company's major and most successful aesthetic trends of those years— the creation of jewels including such 'gems'. He thus continued a well-established classical tradition (coins were lavishly used in the ancient world as adorning elements) while obtaining completely modern and original results.

Since then, Nicola has become a world-renowned collector of antique silver, having personally acquired at auction several rare examples of silver pieces of the Roman school which are currently on exhibit in the Via Condotti flagship store.

Indeed, his passion for silver is reflected in the mission he has been performing since the 1960's – that of setting up a substantial collection of silver items manufactured by Bvlgari where technical perfection meets with contemporary design and functionality.

He collects contemporary works of art and vintage American automobiles.

CLAUDIO COSTAMAGNA

Claudio retired from Goldman Sachs in May 2006 after 18 years. He was the Chairman of the Investment Banking Division for Europe, The Middle East and Africa following his role as co-head of the Investment Banking Division in Europe for Goldman Sachs International since 2001. From 1999 to 2001, he was co-head of Investment Banking Services in Europe. Prior to this, he was the head of the Italian team for the Investment Banking Division in London and the Chairman of Goldman Sachs SIM S.p.A. He was a member of the firm's Partnership Committee and the European Management Committee.

Prior to joining Goldman Sachs in 1988, he was at Montedison S.p.A. in the Group Finance Department for three years and with Citibank in Italy for four years.

Claudio received a degree in business administration from Bocconi University in 1980. He is a member of the board for Luxottica Group, Value Partners and DEA Capital and is the Chairman of the Alumni association of Bocconi University.

Claudio Sposito is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Clessidra. Before founding Clessidra, he was Chief Executive Officer at Fininvest S.p.A. for 5 years and Managing Director at Morgan Stanley & Co for 10 years, where he was head of Investment Banking in Italy. He also worked at other leading international financial institutions, including Barclays Bank, Standard Chartered and Citibank.

He holds an MBA from American University in Washington, D.C. and a degree in Architecture from the University of Rome. He speaks Italian and English.

Francesco Trapani **Chief Executive Officer of the Bulgari Group**

Francesco Trapani is Chief Executive Officer of the Bulgari Group, the Italian contemporary jeweler and today one of the leading global players in the luxury market offering world famous fine jewelry, watches, accessories and fragrances.

After receiving his degree in Economics from the University of Naples and studying Business Administration at the New York University, Francesco Trapani became the Company's Chief Executive in 1984. Starting from the '80s Bulgari expanded internationally and Mr. Trapani brought to the Company both financial planning and a long-term strategy based on product diversification, global distribution as well as professional organization.

In July 1995 Mr. Trapani successfully led the listing of Bulgari SpA on the Italian Stock Exchange and the stock is also currently traded on the IRS service of the London Stock Exchange. In 2000 the Bulgari Group acquired 100% of Gerald Genta S.A., Daniel Roth S.A., Swiss leaders in high-end watch making, and Manufacture de Haute Horlogerie S.A., the owner of the related manufacturing facilities. In February 2001 Bulgari announced the creation of Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts, a joint venture between Bulgari and Marriott International / Ritz-Carlton.

Through these steps, the Bulgari Group has become a major success story within the luxury business.

Born in Rome in 1957 and son of Agostino Trapani and Lia Bulgari, Francesco Trapani is legally separated and has three children. He fluently speaks Italian, English and French. He personally owns a 4.41% share of the company.
